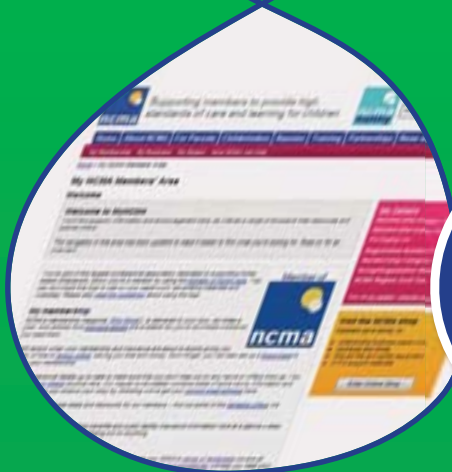

- Complete an introductory childcare training course and an accredited 12-hour paediatric first-aid course ✓
- Join NCMA to be part of a professional organisation ✓
- Apply to join the Ofsted Voluntary Register/CSSIW Childcare Approval Scheme; they'll carry out an enhanced CRB check. You can tick the declaration on the Ofsted/CSSIW application form saying that you hold PLI Insurance ✓
- To take up the offer of NCMA insurance provide NCMA with your Ofsted/CSSIW register number within 90 days of joining and we will validate your insurance ✓
